November 1st

Boynton Canyon Trail

Enjoy this 6.1-mile out-and-back trail near Sedona, Arizona. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 2 - 3hrs to complete. Beautiful canyob walls and hopefully some color change at the back of the canyon.

Level 3.5

Directions: From Cottonwood-Head to Sedona, When enter Sedona turn left on Dry Creek Rd. Follow all the way out to 1st T and turn left. Follow to the 2nd T and turn right. Boynton Canyon parking lot on right side of road. NOTE: Red rock passes needed.

November 8th

Doe Mesa Trail

Beautiful climb up to the Mesa for even better views! Ultimately do around 2.5 miles. The hike up will get you breathing. And once up there can do some sit and stare or walk the perimeter.

Level 2.5 (a 3 if you are not used to a elevation gain-511ft)

Directions: From Cottonwood - Head to Sedona. Once in Sedona turn left on Dry Creek Rd. Follow all the way to the 1st T and turn left. Follow to 2nd T and turn left, Go past Fay canyon parking and then park in lot on the left at Doe Mesa. Note: need red rock pass.

November 15th

Baldwin Trail

Awesome loop trail in the VOC area. About 3.5 miles Boasting beautiful views of Cathedral rock. Hike this one counter clock wise and end up at red rock crossing so dogs can swim!

Level 2.5

Directions From cottonwood - Get on 89A towards Sedona, turn right on Cornville road. Follow all the way to Beaver head flats road and turn left. Then follow to the Verde Valley School Road Round about left. Follow Verde Valley school road all the way to dirt. Then keep going another mile or so. Parking lot will be on left.

November 22

Tavasci Marsh

Great back yard hike/walk. Cruise near the Verde River and out to the marsh taking in a view of Tuzigoot. 2.5 miles

Level 1.5

Directions From Cottonwood - Head out towards Clarkdale via old town way. Turn right to go towards Tuzigoot. Then shortly after the bridge turn right onto dirt road that goes below to the bridge area. Park on the left side area parking space.

November 29th
